SECURITY GROUP DETACHMENT (NAVSECGRU DET), GROTON, CT

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to disestablish subject shore activity and CNO approval to establish subject detachment per reference (a).

2. Background. The disestablishment of subject activity, proposed by Commander, Naval Security Group Command (NAVSECGRU), is part of overall transformation of NAVSECGRUCOM as it merges into Naval Network Warfare Command. NAVSECGRU determined that current mission at Groton can be carried out by a NAVSECGRU detachment. Detachment will be subordinate to NAVSECGRUACT Fort Gordon, GA.
