This is a final response to your letter of 25 June 2003 requesting a mandatory declassification review of the following documents:

- “1) The President’s Daily Brief (PDB) or President’s Intelligence Check List (PICL); and
- 2) The National Intelligence (NID); and
- 3) The Central Intelligence Bulletin (CIB):


for the following series of dates: June 14-22, 1972 (Watergate Plumbers Arrested).”

We completed a thorough search of our records and located documents responsive to your request. We determined that 13 documents may be released in sanitized form. We have deleted material that must remain classified on the basis of Sections 3.3(b)(1) and (6) of the Order (as amended 2003). Additional information while no longer meeting the requirements for classification must be withheld on the basis of Section 3.5(c) of the Order. Enclosed are copies of these documents showing our deletions and citing the exemptions.

We also found material that we determined must remain classified on the basis of Sections 3.3(b)(1) and (6) of the Order (as amended 2003) and cannot be released in sanitized form.

As the CIA Information and Privacy Coordinator, I am the CIA official responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this response to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 45 days from the date of this letter. Please include the basis of your appeal.
