SUBJECT: INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY MODIFICATIONS TO ANNEX C, "ADJUDICATIVE GUIDELINES FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR ACCESS TO CLASSIFIED INFORMATION", TO DCID 6/4, "PERSONNEL SECURITY STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR ACCESS TO SENSITIVE COMPARTMENTED INFORMATION"

A. AUTHORITY: The National Security Act of 1947, as amended; the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004; Executive Order 12333, as amended; Executive Order 13354; Executive Order 13355; and other applicable provisions of law.

B. PURPOSE: This memorandum officially modifies the policy provisions in the Director of Central Intelligence Directive 6/4, Annex C, Adjudicative Guidelines for Determining Eligibility for Access to Classified Information, to reflect the national policy amendments approved by the President. These amendments are contained in the attachment.

C. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Intelligence Community Policy Memorandum becomes effective on the date of signature and the contents will be incorporated into an Intelligence Community Directive.
