**Statement of the Inspectors General of the
Intelligence Community, the Central Intelligence Agency,
the Department of Justice, and the Department of Homeland Security
Regarding the
IC IG Forum Review of the Boston Marathon Bombings**

(U) The Inspectors General of the Intelligence Community, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Department of Justice, and the Department of Homeland Security have initiated a coordinated and independent review into the U.S. Government's handling of intelligence information leading up to the Boston Marathon Bombings. The Director of National Intelligence supports the review, which will examine the information available to the U.S. Government before the bombings and the information sharing protocols and procedures followed between and among the intelligence and law enforcement agencies. We will coordinate our reviews in such a manner as to reduce duplication of effort and to ensure that they do not interfere any ongoing intelligence activities or criminal investigations and prosecutions related to the Boston Marathon Bombings.
