SUBJECT: FY 1972 Underground Nuclear Test Program (GROMMET)

The President has approved in principle the Underground Nuclear Test Program for FY 1972 (GROMMET) as set forth in the Chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission's letter of 11 June 1971 to the Chairman of the NSC Under Secretaries Committee. The detailed test program for the first half of FY 1972 (GROMMET-I) is approved for implementation. However, it is understood that the President's decision concerning the CANNIKIN test will be handled as a separate action.
